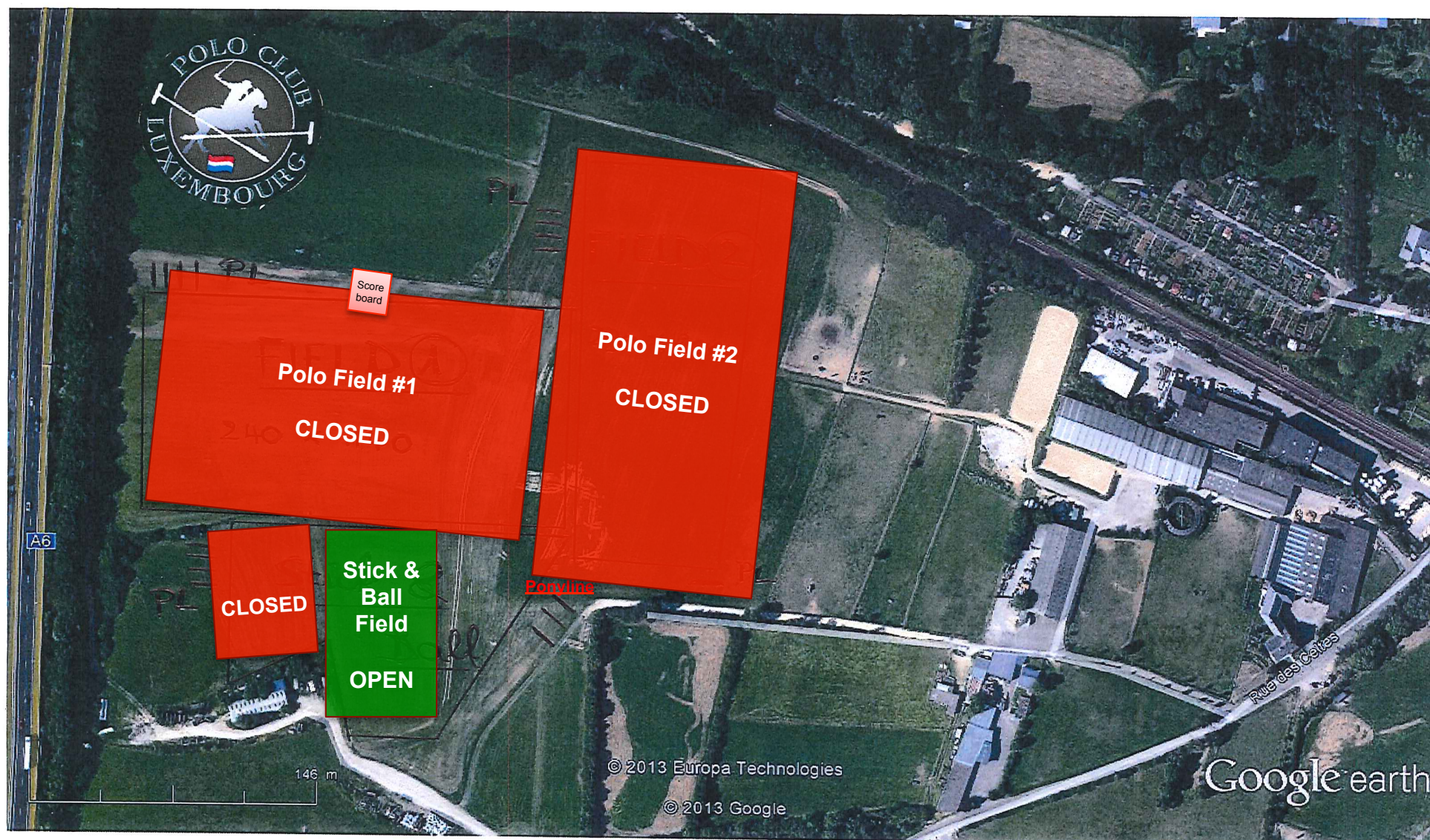

Polo Field #1: Reserved for tournaments, when weather conditions allow

Polo Field #2: Reserved for our weekly Club Chuckers (Wednesday 18:30h / Saturday 16:00h / Sunday 11:00h), when weather conditions allow

Stick & Ball: Stick & Ball (S&B) can be done on this field, when weather conditions allow to use the field.

Each player is responsible for maintaining the fields in good conditions. If you doubt on the usability of the field please confirm with our trainer Florencia Albertarrio (mob. +352 691 208 881) or Alexander Ludorf (mob. +352 621 226 303).

If you plan to do a S&B session we recommend members to inform the trainer well in advance. During working hours the trainer will accompany you. Only in company of the trainer and after explicit approval of the trainer you may use field #2 for S&B, depending on weather conditions.

We recommend you to always use the S&B field in a company or a group of players to have someone to help in case of accidents (call 112).

We appreciate all horse riders that are not members of the Polo Club Luxembourg not to enter the fields of the Club to prevent any damages and responsibilities. If you would like to use the fields and try out polo we would be more than happy and ask you to contact our trainer (phone number see above) and go to our website www.polo.lu for further information on polo training possibilities and prices!

Each player is responsible for maintaining the fields in good conditions! We have invested a lot of money and time in our polo fields. Horse riding on the fields during bad weather conditions/too soft grounds can cause holes in the ground. It involves a lot of work to fill these holes manually with sand or roll the ground to re-establish the quality of the field – to play great polo on great grounds, today and in the future! Please, remind yourself and others!
